Government College, Attingal was privileged to be the Management Partner Institution (MPI) to facilitate two Skill Courses on

(1) Certificate in Accounting Technician (150 Hours) and
(2) Global Business Foundation Skill Course (150 Hours) along with the Foundation Module tailored under the Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP). The programme is an initiative of the Departments of Higher Education and General Education, Government of Kerala, with a view to improve the employability quotient of students studying in the Undergraduate students of Arts and Science Colleges.

Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP) in fact, is part of the State Skill Development Project designed with the objective of advancement of Skill proficiency and Development in Kerala that became operational since July 2012.

- Development of one's personality by being aware of the self, connecting with others, reflecting on the abstract and the concrete, leading and generating change, and staying rooted in time-tested values and principles is being aimed at.
- To enhance the employability and maximize the potential of the students by introducing those to the principles that underlay personal and professional success, and help them acquire the skills needed to apply these principles in their lives and careers

COURSE OUTCOME:

- Define and Identify different life skills required in personal and professional life.
- Learn the basics of teamwork and leadership
- Develop an awareness of the self and apply well-defined techniques to cope with emotions and stress.
