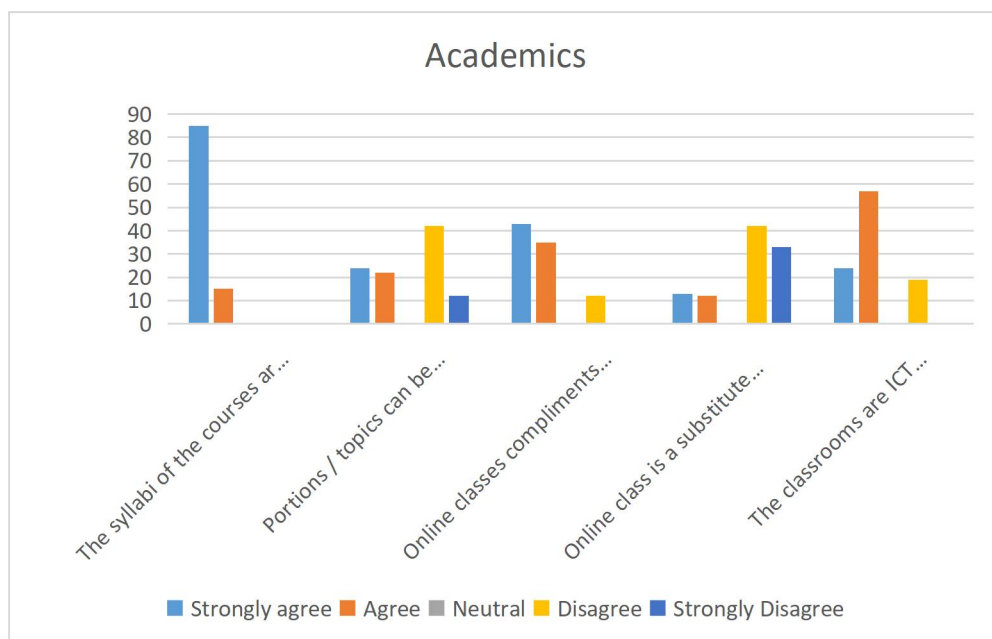


Teacher's Feedback Report 2021-2022

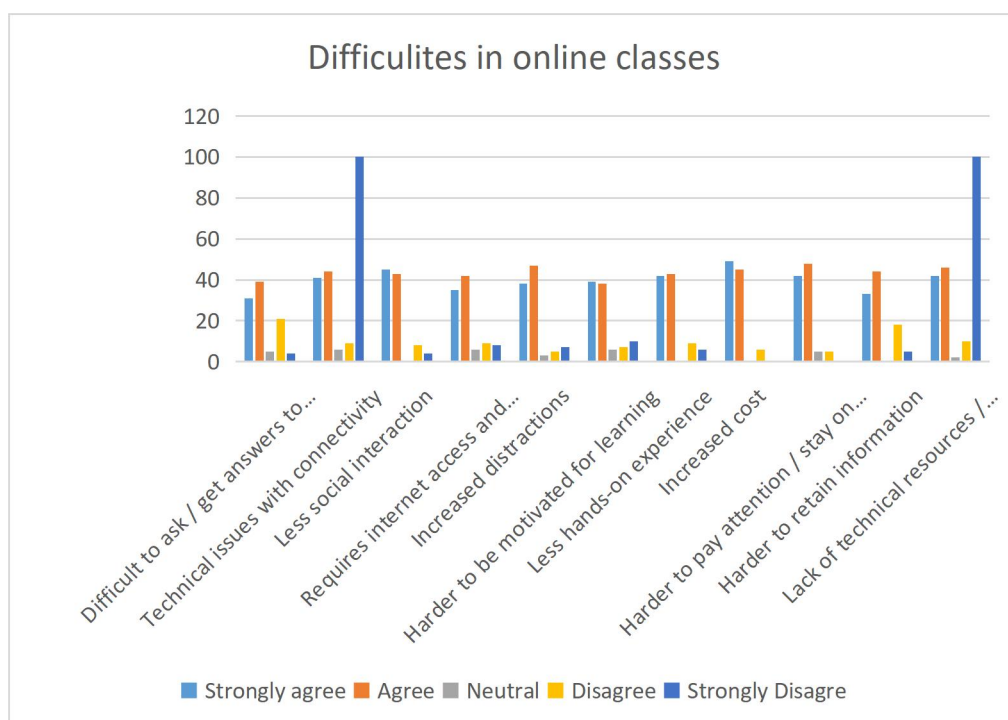

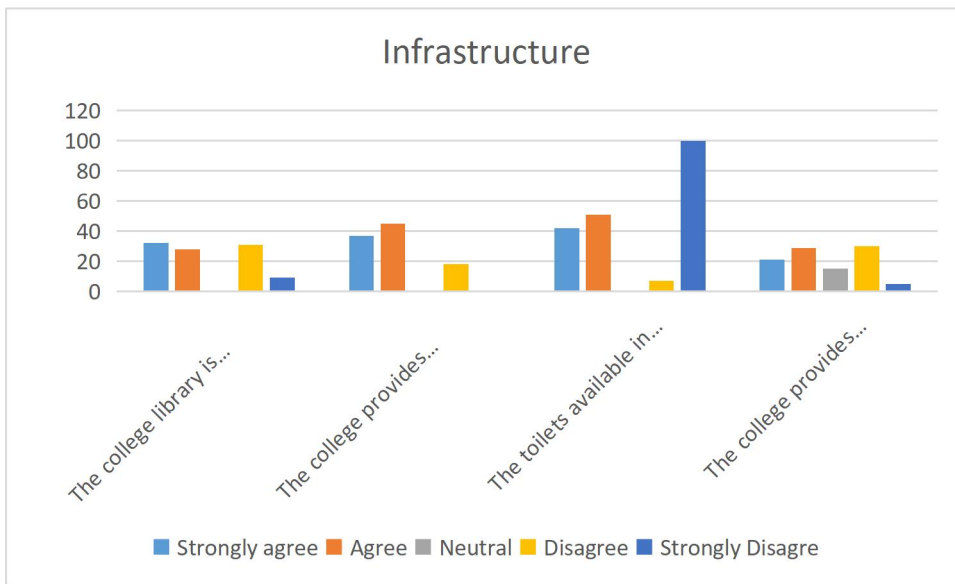
1. Opinion about Academics



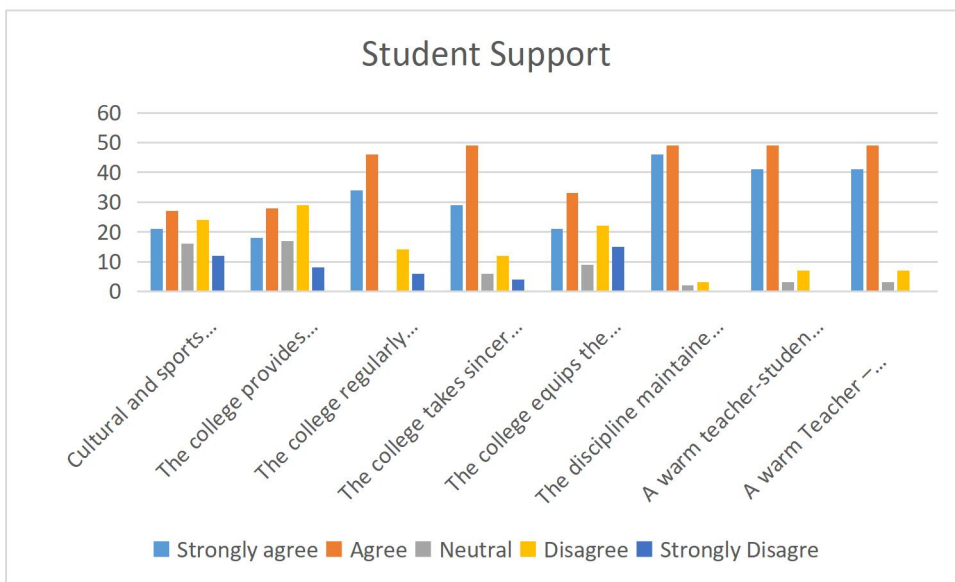
2. Difficulties in conducting online classes



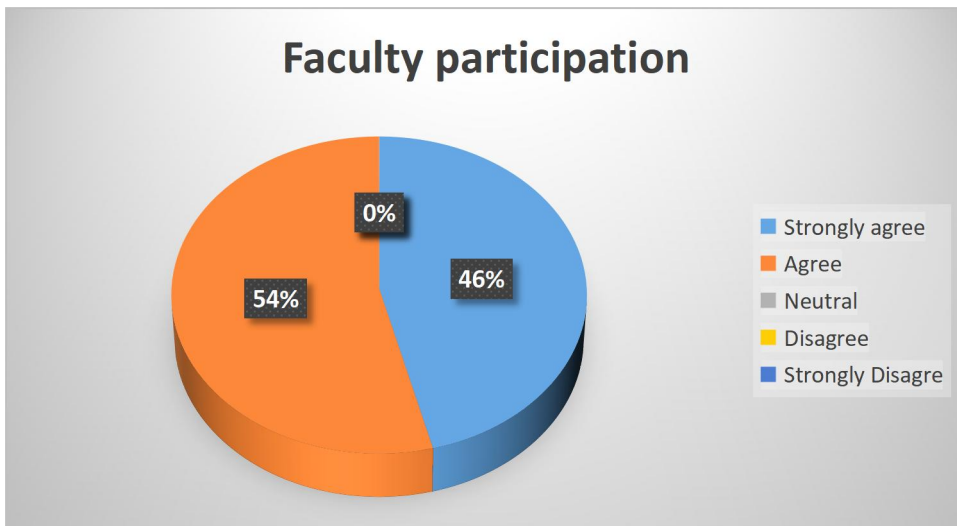

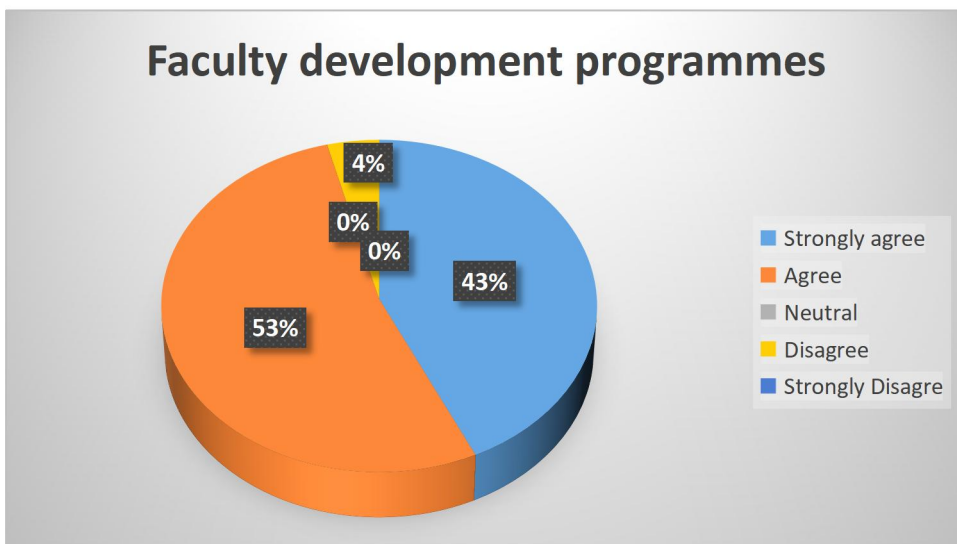

Feedback report

The teachers are very much satisfied about the infrastructure and academic environment existing in the college and there is suggestion for the improvement of the sports facilities and also the internet facility of the college have to be strengthened. warm relationships are maintained between teachers and students and between teachers and parents. Teachers are very much satisfied with the support for the faculty participation in conference, seminars etc. and also with the training programmes conducted in the college. Major problems confronted by the teachers regarding the online classes are technical issues with connectivity, lack of gadgets, less hands-on experience, lack of social interactions etc.
